Dr. Ram Manohar Lohiya National Law University, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh is a premier Law University established under 'Doctor Ram Manohar Lohiya National Law University Uttar Pradesh Act, 2005' (Uttar Pradesh Act No. 28 Of 2005).

The University is fully funded by the Government of Uttar Pradesh. The campus of the university is spread across 40 acres of land at the heart of the capital city Lucknow. Proximity of the university to the High Court of Judicature Allahabad, Lucknow Bench, several District Courts, Civil and Sessions Courts, Fast Track Courts and Tribunals in the radius of ten kilometers. The aim of the university is to impart comprehensive legal education, advancement and dissemination of learning and knowledge of law and awakening among the students a sense of responsibilities to serve society in the field of law by developing skills in advocacy, judicial and other legal services, legislation and legal reforms. Several legal luminaries and the renowned members of the Bar are showing their active interest by participating in and contributing to the academic activities of the University and share their valuable experiences at the Bar or the Bench, with the students and the faculty of the university.

Since 2006, the university has started B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) five year integrated course. From academic session 2007 - 08 the university has also started two year residential LL.M. degree course with an intake of 20 students.

Excellent infrastructural facilities such as modern library (digital and print) with computer and internet facility, air-conditioned academic, administrative, library and moot court blocks, separate hostels for boys and girls, campus accommodation for the faculty and the supporting staff, in-campus utilities and amenities have been created with a view to ensure best possible environs and ambience to facilitate the excellence in legal education. Campus-wide networking/Internet facility through Wi-Fi system enables the students & faculty to have unlimited access to the vistas of knowledge.

The Dr. RMLNLU is proud of its vibrant student community which has excelled in curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. Students are undertaking project works assigned to them and are attending the Moot Court and other activities regularly. Various teams of the students have participated in the Moot Court Competitions organized by different National Law Universities. One team of this University won

Gold Medal & the Best Researcher Award in Henry Dunant International Moot Court Competition organized by ISIL, New Delhi in this academic year. Another team of this University won the third prize in the National Moot Court Competition, held at National Law University, Jodhpur. Still another Moot Court team is going to participate in Manfred Lachs International Moot Court Competition, 2008 to be held at Sydney.

The University is striving to promote legal learning among its students. The University has organized several extension lectures in the field of Law and Legal Matters. Hon'ble Justice Brijesh Kumar (Retired) from Supreme Court of India, Hon'ble Chief Justice Mr. H.L. Gokhale, Hon'ble Justice Pradeep Kant, Hon'ble Justice Mr. Alok Kumar Singh, from High Court of Judicature at Allahabad and Prof. S.S. Juss, King's College, London University, Prof. B.B. Pandey, Ex-Professor, Delhi University and Prof. C.M. Jariwala, former Dean and the Head of the Department, BHU have been kind enough to address, illumine and encourage our students for grasping the knowledge of law and enhancing legal acumen.

There is a rigorous internship programme which every student of Dr. RMLNLU is required to undergo as part of the curriculum. During these internships, a student has to compulsorily work with NGOs, Lawyers or Legal firms etc after second semester during summer semester break regularly.

B.A. LL.B. (Hons.): Five Year Integrated Course

Admission Procedure:

Admission shall be made on the basis of the scores of COMMON LAW ADMISSION TEST (CLAT - 2008) to be held on Sunday 11th of May, 2008. This University is not selling any separate application form for admission in this University.

How to apply for CLAT:

a) **Off-line:** Printed application forms for CLAT-2008 along with the brochure are available at the designated branches of the Corporation Bank and State Bank of India against the payment of Rs. 2,000/- only. State Bank of India, Hazaratganj, Lucknow and Corporation Bank, Kaiserbagh, Lucknow are the only two designated branches in the U.P. For other States details may be seen on www.clat.ac.in. Applications may also be obtained by sending a request to the Convener, CLAT, National Law School of India University, Bangalore - 560 242, with a demand draft for Rs. 2,000/- drawn in favour of the Convener, CLAT, and payable at Bangalore.

b) **On-line:** For online submission of applications, visit www.clat.ac.in. The completed and printed Online CLAT - 2008 application form should be sent to the Convener, CLAT at the above address along with DD for Rs. 2,000/- drawn in favour of Convener, CLAT, payable at Bangalore.

How to Apply for This University: Along with the Admit Card (Hall Ticket) for CLAT-2008 exam, candidates will receive one OMR application form. Candidates seeking admission in this University will be required to mark their choice for this University in this OMR form and hand it over to the Centre in-Charge of the center concerned on 11th of May, 2008. This University is not selling any separate application form for admission in this University.

Last date for sending the filled in application form of CLAT - 2008 along with the enclosures is 10th of April, 2008.

Eligibility for Admission:

The admission shall be based exclusively on the performance in the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT). However, to qualify for admission the candidate must have passed intermediate (10+2 system) or equivalent examination from a University/recognized board with not less than 50% (for SC/ST of U.P. 45%) marks and is not more than 20 years (22 years in case of SC/ST of U.P.) of age as on 01.07.2008. Students taking qualifying examination in March/April 2008 are also eligible to apply.

Intake and Reservation:

The intake capacity of B.A., LL.B. (Hons.) degree programme shall be 160 with following breakup:

Horizontal reservation to the physically challenged persons shall also be admissible as per U.P. State Govt. rules.

LL.M. Programme

The University offers two years LL.M. programme. The annual intake is 20 students.

Admission Procedure:

Admission shall be made on the basis of the scores of COMMON LAW ADMISSION TEST (CLAT - 2008) to be held on Sunday 11th of May, 2008, as stated above for B.A. LL.B. (Hons.).

Eligibility for Admission:

A candidate should have secured a LL.B. degree or its equivalent from a recognized University, having obtained not less than 50% (45% in case of SC/ST of U.P.) marks in the aggregate. Candidates in the final year of their LL.B. course can also apply but their admission would be confirmed only after they submit LL.B. results with the required 50% marks in aggregate.

The intake capacity of LL.M. degree programme shall be 20 with following breakup:

(a)	General Category	:	10
(b)	OBC of U.P.	:	05
(c)	Scheduled Caste of U.P.	:	04
(d)	Scheduled Tribe of U.P.	:	01

Horizontal reservation to the physically challenged persons shall also be admissible as per U.P. State Govt. rules.
