	Applicant should be in the disciplines of Political Science, Public Administration, International Relations or other disciplines relevant to Democracy and Election Management.

**5.2. Professor-cum-Dean, School of Electoral Law**

<b>No of Posts</b>	<b>1</b>
<b>Eligibility</b>	Applicant must hold a regular post in the grade of Professor as per UGC norms in a Central/ State Government-funded University or an Institution (created under State or Central Law)
	Applicant should be in the discipline of Law or related discipline.

**5.3. Assistant Professor – School of Electoral Law**

<b>No of Posts</b>	<b>2</b>
<b>Eligibility</b>	The applicant must hold a regular post in the grade of <b>Assistant Professor</b> as per UGC norms in a Central/ State Government-funded University or an Institution (created under State/ Central Law)
	The applicant should be in the discipline of Law, political science or related discipline but preference will be given to the candidates teaching in the subject/ discipline of Law.

**5.4. Assistant Professor-cum-Head, Centre for Curriculum Development**

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<b>Eligibility</b>	Must hold a regular post in the grade of Assistant Professor as per UGC norms in a Central/ State Government-funded University or an Institution (created under State/ Central Law)
	Applicant should be in the disciplines of Political Science, Public Administration, International Relations or other disciplines relevant to Democracy and Election Management.  The Applicant having experience of curriculum design will be preferred.

## 6. Responsibilities of the Academic Faculties

The Academic Faculties will have the following broad responsibilities in their respective areas:

(i) Academic Programme Development and Delivery

Design and deliver academic courses such as master's programme, certificate courses, and specialized programmes for national and international stakeholders in democracy and election management.

(ii) Research and Knowledge Creation

Conduct research studies in democracy and election management, contribute to publications in national and international journals, and support the study of international electoral standards, global best practices.

(iii) Teaching and Capacity Building

Conduct teaching and training sessions in academic and training programmes for national and international stakeholders in democracy and election management.

(iv) Academic Collaboration and Knowledge Exchange

Participate in academic and professional communities to promote knowledge exchange, contribute to joint academic initiatives in election management, support the establishment of Centre of Electoral Management (CEM) in partner institutions, and share best practices through workshops and seminars.

(v) Representation and Advocacy:

Represent IIIDEM in national and international academic forums, conferences, and expert discussions etc.

(vi) Academic Coordination

Work in coordination with the Dean and senior faculty to contribute to the school's academic and training objectives.

## 7. General Terms and Conditions

The general terms and conditions for filling up of the posts by way deputation are:

- (i) The pay, allowances, and other terms and conditions of officers appointed on deputation shall be governed in terms of extant guidelines issued by the University Grants Commission (UGC), as amended from time to time.
- (ii) All applicants are required to apply **through email at [head-hr-iiidem@eci.gov.in](mailto:head-hr-iiidem@eci.gov.in)** in the prescribed format with complete and correct information. Applicants are required to fill the application form as available on the IIIDEM website [www.iiidem.eci.gov.in](http://www.iiidem.eci.gov.in).
- (iii) The selected candidates will be required to submit a 'No Objection Certificate' and a 'Vigilance Clearance Certificate' issued by the authorized signatory of their parent organization at the time of final selection and prior to the issuance of the appointment order. Indicative proformas for these certificates are available on the IIIDEM website ([www.iiidem.eci.gov.in](http://www.iiidem.eci.gov.in)), in the corresponding vacancy advertisement.
- (iv) The period of deputation shall, initially be for a period of three years, which may be extended. Applicants should preferably have at least three years of service remaining before the date of superannuation. However, cases with lesser residual service may also be considered based on suitability and administrative requirements.
- (v) The Institute reserves the right to reject any application or to modify, cancel, or withhold the process for any or all of the advertised posts, at any stage and without assigning any reason.
